

Тематический урок по теме «Патриотическое воспитание учащихся на уроке Английского языка»

Цели: 1) обучающая: реализуется через обучение диалогическому и монологическому высказыванию; 2) развивающая: развитие внимания, памяти, языковой догадки, мышления, воображения; 3) воспитывающая: развитие чувства патриотизма у учащихся и формирование нравственных качеств — гордость за Россию, уважение к людям, которые ее прославили, желание узнать как можно больше о своей стране.

Задачи: активизация лексики по теме в форме диалогических и монологических высказываний, чтение текста, введение новой лексики, подготовка монологических высказываний.

План урока:

1. Введение в тему урока, распределение по командам, названия команд.
2. Задание 1 «Интеллектуальный квиз» (за каждый правильный ответ команда получает 1 балл)
3. Задание 2 Чтение текста о Дне Защитника Отечества и выполнение заданий по тексту (Утверждения по тексту: правда или ложь)
4. Задание 3 «Известные люди». Ученикам необходимо посмотреть на портреты значимых для России людей, назвать их имена (1 балл), сказать, что сделали для России (1 балл).
5. Задание 4 «Поиск слов». Найти в кроссворде все слова, кто первый из двух команд завершит выполнение задания, тому 2 балла, проигравшей команде — 1 балл.
6. Подведение итогов, выводы, рефлексия.

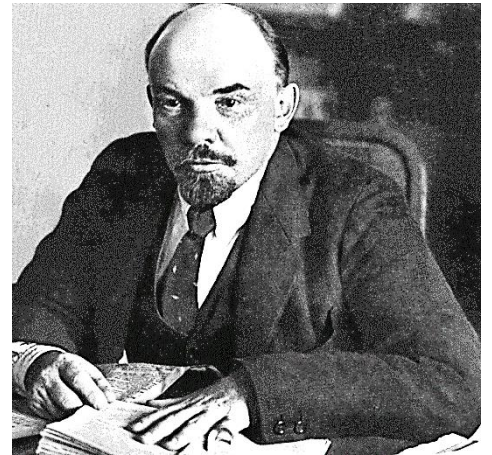
